

2008 APPLICATION FOR THE VSGA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OF THE VIRGINIA GOLF FOUNDATION

In order to be eligible for a scholarship, individuals must submit the following items with their application:

1. The names, addresses and telephone numbers of three character references.
2. A letter from a representative of a VSGA member club recommending the individual for consideration for a Virginia Golf Foundation scholarship.
3. His/her high school transcript and SAT or PSAT score results. Include current transcripts from any college or university for work completed. If this information is being provided by the school directly to the Virginia Golf Foundation, it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all information arrives by the deadline.
4. On a separate attachment, please respond to the following questions in an essay of 500 words or less:
 - ✱ *In what way has golf influenced your life, and what role will golf play in your future plans?*
 - ✱ *Why are you applying for this scholarship?*
 - ✱ *What are your career plans upon completion of your undergraduate degree?*

Eligibility for scholarships:

- Any Virginia high school senior in good standing who has been domiciled in Virginia since Sept. 1, 2007.
- Candidates must be in good academic standing at any high school or equivalent level institution acceptable to the Virginia Golf Foundation.



Conditions of grants:

- Grants must be used for tuition, room and other educational expenses approved by the Virginia Golf Foundation for education in a Virginia institution of higher learning.
- Payments will be made only to the institution or to such Virginia Golf Foundation approved payee.

Consideration for a scholarship is based on the following criteria:

- Does candidate play golf or have any interest in an activity associated with golf (golf skill and ability are neither requirements nor considerations)?
- Candidate's academic achievement (GPA and standardized test scores).
- Candidate's character (activities outside the classroom including work, community service, school clubs, etc.).
- Essay to the Virginia Golf Foundation (see #4 on reverse side).
- Financial need will be a factor in the final evaluation of scholarship applicants.
- All applications must be received by 5 p.m. Friday, Feb. 29, 2008. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide all information by the deadline.
- All applications must be made on behalf of the candidate by a representative of a member club of the Virginia State Golf Association, Inc. and forwarded to:
